



House Rules

Stand: Januar 2010

1. These house rules apply to the whole operational area of "Flughafen Bremen GmbH" (Bremen Airport). They present a summarised explanation of existing legal general conditions (such as the "Flughafenbenutzungs-Ordnung" / Airport Usage Regulations), which remain unaffected by these house rules.
2. Visitors and users of the terminal must behave in such a way that they do not unduly disturb or inconvenience others.
Instructions given by the staff of Flughafen Bremen GmbH and Bremen Airport Service GmbH must be obeyed.
3. Smoking within the buildings is forbidden. Smoking is allowed in certain specially designated rooms after being granted permission by Flughafen Bremen GmbH.
Dogs must be kept on a lead.
4. Disposing of rubbish is permitted only in the waste bins provided for this purpose.
Lost property must be handed in at the airport information desk in the terminal.
5. Baggage or other items, including goods or containers provided for the goods, must not be left unattended. The use of inflammable or potentially explosive material as well as malodorous substances is forbidden on the entire operational premises and throughout the buildings.
6. Promotional representations, notices and events of any kind are subject to prior permission of Flughafen Bremen GmbH. This also applies to any form of fundraising. Begging is forbidden.
Carrying out passenger surveys and other censuses, distributing advertising and propaganda material as well as any activities of a commercial nature are subject to prior permission of Flughafen Bremen GmbH.
7. Producing photographs, video or film material for commercial or propagandistic purposes is not allowed without prior permission from Flughafen Bremen GmbH.
8. Remaining inside the terminals during the times when these are closed can be permitted by the terminal supervision in individual cases provided a valid flight ticket/valid boarding pass is presented.
9. Noncompliance with these house rules can result in being banned by Flughafen Bremen GmbH from re-entering their premises. We reserve the right to claim any costs and damages incurred by the responsible party.
10. Video surveillance is in use in many areas of the airport – also in the terminals.
